The Centre Women of Sweden is one of the largest political women's associations in Sweden. It was founded in 1932 and has been a force for equality ever since, putting women's issues on the political agenda. We are connected to the green liberal Centre Party, which was the first of any political parties in Sweden to appoint women to key leadership positions such as Party Leader, Minister of Foreign Affairs (Secretary of State), and Minister of Gender Equality.

We believe that a society in which men and women are equal is a prerequisite for all people's individual freedom, for social and economical development and sustainability.

We have achieved these important social reforms over the years, some in alliance with other parties:

- First Gender Equality Act & Equality Delegate
- Publicly funded preschools & affordable, high quality childcare
- Child subsidies & family income supplement
- Women's right to be ordained
- The right to contraception, sex education & abortion

We develop policies that focus on solutions in order to achieve a gender equal society, where women are safe from violence and sexual harassment. We stress the importance of shared parental responsibility, equal pay, gender neutral education and the same access to healthcare for women and men. We support women's entrepreneurship and promote women's representation in leadership positions.

THREE ASPECTS OF FREEDOM

The Center Women stress three aspects of freedom in order to reach one's potential as an individual and a society that is fair and safe for everyone.



Financial freedom

- Everyone, men and women, should be able to reach financial autonomy and empowerment
- Everyone should have equal opportunity to ownership
- Unpaid work, particularly domestic chores, should be shared equally
- Equal pay for equal work, regardless of gender



Sexual freedom and women's health

- Everyone, men and women, should have the right and the opportunities to stay in good health
- Everyone should have the right to physical integrity
- Bodies should not be treated as objects or commodities
- Everyone should have the right and the opportunity to freely define one's sexuality



Structural freedom

- Everyone, men and women, should have the right and the opportunity to make decisions for one's life
- Everyone should be entitled to a life free from violence and oppression
- Everyone should be entitled to freedom from discrimination
- Everyone should be entitled to feel safe in society
